

Call for applications – The Rebecca Dratofsky Postdoctoral Scholarship in Nanoscience & Nanotechnology 2026,

The Technion Human Health Initiative (THHI), on behalf of the Lorry I. Lokey Interdisciplinary Center for Life Sciences & Engineering, is offering a Postdoctoral scholarship for research to be carried out at the Technion in fields related to Regenerative Medicine and Stem Cell Biology.

Candidates must have received their PhD degree with 5 years of the current application.

The selected postdoctoral fellow will be awarded up to **\$35,000** for one year.

The host is expected to provide the following documents:

- A short cover letter by the Technion supervisor (the host) that explicitly states his or her commitment to hosting the postdoctoral fellow.
- The candidate's CV, which is to include a list of publications.
- A brief description of the candidate's research program (up to 2 pages) that should include:
 - Introduction
 - Aims
 - Workplan
 - References (not included in the 2-page limit)
- Two recommendation letters

The THHI will inform the host and the hosting faculty whether the scholarship was awarded within 1-2 months of the application deadline below.

Following approval, the host faculty will apply to the Executive Vice President for Academic Affairs with all the required documentation and the approval letter, in accordance with Technion's academic regulations.
